The Leningrad Dutch is an uncompromising opening which will suit players who like to play for a win as Black. It is an acquired taste and serious preparation is essential. It can also be reached by transposition via the English Opening (1 c4) and the Reti Opening (1 Nf3) although a good grasp of the various move orders is essential.

One needs deep understanding in order to treat correctly such types of positions.

Thanks. If by QGD move order, you mean 1.d4 d5 2.c4 e6 3.Nc3 f5, this used to be considered inferior, as it lets White play Bf4 and Bd3. The Triangle move order is perhaps better 1.d4 d5 2. c4 e6 3.Nc3 c6 4.e3 f5, but still not ideal and, of course, you're not guaranteed to get to a Dutch.

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
