The family-separation policy is unpopular among Americans, as shown by four polls; on average, two-thirds of Americans oppose the policy. [310] [311] [312] There is a strong partisan divide; the average of polls showed that Democrats are overwhelmingly opposed to the policy (8% support, 87% oppose, 5% other) while a plurality of Republicans favor it (49% support, 35% oppose, 16% other).
