In our Snapshot, several aspects of technology were highlights for first-generation students. First-generation students showed statistically significant differences in their experience with student services portals (4.40 vs. mean of 4.25, out of 5) and using technology hardware like laptops, desktops, and printers (4.25 vs. mean of 4.00, out of 5).
